



The History of the Firm

The Firm was started prior to the First World War by Mr Gough-Thomas in Ellesmere. In 1954 the former Senior Partner, John Scott joined the partnership.

The current Senior Partner, Mike Kendall, joined Gough-Thomas & Scott in 1984 as a Trainee Solicitor and became a Partner in 1988. Ken Law joined the firm as a Trainee Solicitor in 1996 and became a Partner in January 2000. John Scott retired from the partnership in 1998.

On 1st January 2000 Gough-Thomas & Scott opened its Oswestry office at 31 Salop Road. Christine Kendall, who was formerly a Partner in another local firm, joined the Gough-Thomas & Scott partnership at the same time, based in the Oswestry office. She is still with the firm in the capacity of a Consultant.

Claire Andrews joined the firm as a Trainee Solicitor in 2000 and became a Partner in January 2007. Katie Jones joined the firm as a Trainee Solicitor in 2006 and became a Partner in January 2015.
